The Imperial Valley Continuum of Care Council (IVCCC) is committed to eradicating homelessness in Imperial County. As part of this mission, the Point-in-Time (PIT) Committee was established to lead the county's efforts in conducting the annual homeless count, which will take place during the last 10 days of January 2025. The PIT Committee consists of local, state, and federal agencies, non-profit organizations, veterans' groups, faith-based congregations, and community members. Together, these organizations provide supportive services to those experiencing homelessness through emergency shelter, transitional and permanent housing, as well as other supportive services.
